

2024 World Bank Children's Art Prize Judging Packet

Theme: Livable Planet

Jury Members:

Judging Date:

- March 28, 2024, 1:30-3:30PM, at World Bank Main Complex (1818 H Street, NW, Washington, DC).

Age Group Categories:

- 3-6 years old – 210 entries
- 7-12 years old – 389 entries
- 13-18 years old – 90 entries

Scoring:

- Evaluate each of the top 25 selections according to the criteria, assigning scores from 1 (lowest) to 5 (highest) for each:
 - Clarity & Adherence to Theme (Livable Planet): Does the artwork clearly convey a message related to creating or maintaining a livable planet?
 - Creativity & Originality: Does the artwork show unique and imaginative ideas related to the "Livable Planet" theme?
 - Overall Artistic Impression: What is the overall impact of the artwork in its technique, composition, and presentation?

Judging Process:

Step 1: Initial Review

- Judges will receive digital folders containing the scanned entries for each age group on March 26, 2024.
- Judges are encouraged to review the folders of digital images and identify their top 25 by the image number on a scoresheet for each age group (included below).

Note: Judges are not bound by any initial selection. Selections may be changed once artworks are seen in person during the onsite judging.

Step 2: Onsite Judging

- Judges will have 2 hours to review the physically displayed artworks.
- Upon arrival, each juror will receive a scoresheet for each age group (included below).
- The judges will have the opportunity to proceed through the exhibit at their own pace to score the artworks.

Step 3: Compilation of Scores

- Completed scoresheets will be received by a member of the World Bank Art Program team.
- The Art Program team will compile the scoresheets and tally the scores. The results will be shared with judges prior to the notification of the winners.

Selection of Winners:

- The top 3 artworks in each age group, based on cumulative scores, will be declared Age Group Winners.
- The top 3 artworks with the highest overall score across all categories will be declared overall winners.
- The Grand Prize Winner will be awarded to the artwork with the most total points.
- The top 20 runners-up will be declared Honorable Mentions.

Note: In the event of a tie, the President of the Jury will make the final decision.

Recognition of Winners:

- Grand Prize Winner
 - Artwork featured on 2024 World Bank holiday card, including a short biography of the winning artist.
- Grand Prize Winner and Age Group Winners – Top 3 in each age group
 - Art displayed in World Bank President's Office.
 - Personalized certificate from the World Bank President.
 - Identified as winner while on display during World Bank Spring Meetings in April 2024.
 - Recognized in all staff email.
 - Featured on World Bank social media channels.
 - Featured on internal and external web platforms.
- Honorable Mentions – top twenty runners-up.
 - Identified as honorable mentions on display during World Bank Spring Meetings in April 2024.
- Participants – All children submitting art.
 - Art displayed during 2024 World Bank Spring Meetings.
 - Featured on internal and external web platforms.

Notification of Winners:

The Office of the President will inform winning artists and their parents in advance of the Spring Meetings.
