Frequently Asked Questions

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE:

- Can STC/consultants vs Staff with UPI have their child send in artwork?
 - The exhibition is open to the children/step-children of any WBG employee with a regular Bank ID (**with UPI number**), including consultants and selected contractors.
- Are child dependents of retiree staff with UPI able to participate?
 - If the dependent of retired staff with UPI are under 18 years of age, they can participate.
- I work at the bank but do not have children of my own, can a niece or nephew submit artwork?
 - Unfortunately, not. We are very sorry. The contest is only open to children of WBG employees.

WHAT/HOW/WHERE CAN I SUBMIT MY CHILD'S ARTWORK?

- How many or is there a limit on the number of pieces one child can enter?
 - Every child can enter one (1) submission that includes the original artwork (on paper or digital) and a completed entry form.
- Where do I send in digital artwork or photography?
 - We recommend sending a print-out copy of your digital work or photo in the standard size for the contest (11x8.5 inches / 28 x 20 cm). In the case that you decide to send us the digital file, please make sure that the file is in high resolution (300 Pixels Per Inch). You can send the file to artprogram@worldbank.org, subject: "Kids Contest/ to the attention of Mr. Matthew Burke, Registrar".
- Will artworks be returned to me/my child?
 - Artworks will not be returned.
- Where can I see my child's artwork?
 - The exhibition will be physically on view during the 2024 Spring Meetings in the HQ Main Complex and on-line on Yammer. After the juried selection, winning artworks will be on display in the President office.
- How can I mail my child's artwork if there are no COs close to me?
 - You can mail it via regular mail or via courier (DHL preferred) **marked as "Art"**.
